Dear Dorchester Resident,

Together, the Dorchester Community can help to combat crime through the Boston Police Department's New Community Cam-Share Program:

- *The Boston Police Department, District C-11 recently launched a Public Safety Consortium among Dorchester Business Owners with an Information Sharing App, with the goal of bringing Dorchester's Business Community together with the Boston Police Department to strategically plan and coordinate responses to emergency situations. To further this initiative, District C-11 is launching a new initiative to better coordinate, adjudicate, mitigate, prevent and respond to incidents in the community: Cam-Share.*
- *By partnering with our neighbors, private cameras in and around our community can potentially be used as "Force- Multipliers." Enabling Evidence to be quickly located, analyzed, and distributed among various agencies working together within the Criminal Justice System, to identify, locate, apprehend and adjudicate criminals responsible for committing an unlawful act(s).*
- *To ensure success, we, The Boston Police Department, will require the following innocuous information about your camera to help create a robust, geocoded camera location database.*

By joining Can-share the registrant agrees to the following terms and conditions:

1. Any video footage collected by the Boston Police Department relating to criminal activity may be used in the investigation as evidence during any stage of the criminal proceeding
2. Video footage provided to the Boston Police Department is reserved for Official Use Only.
3. Under no circumstances shall registrants construe that they are acting as an agent/or employee of the Boston Police Department through the Community Cam-Share Program
4. When necessary the Boston Police Department will contact you directly using the information you have provided to obtain surveillance video footage
5. You agree not to release any footage or still images to the media without consulting with Boston Police Department Media Relations
